The angel said, “Do not be afraid to take Mary as your wife. She will have a Son and you are to name him Jesus. Jesus will save His people from their sins.”

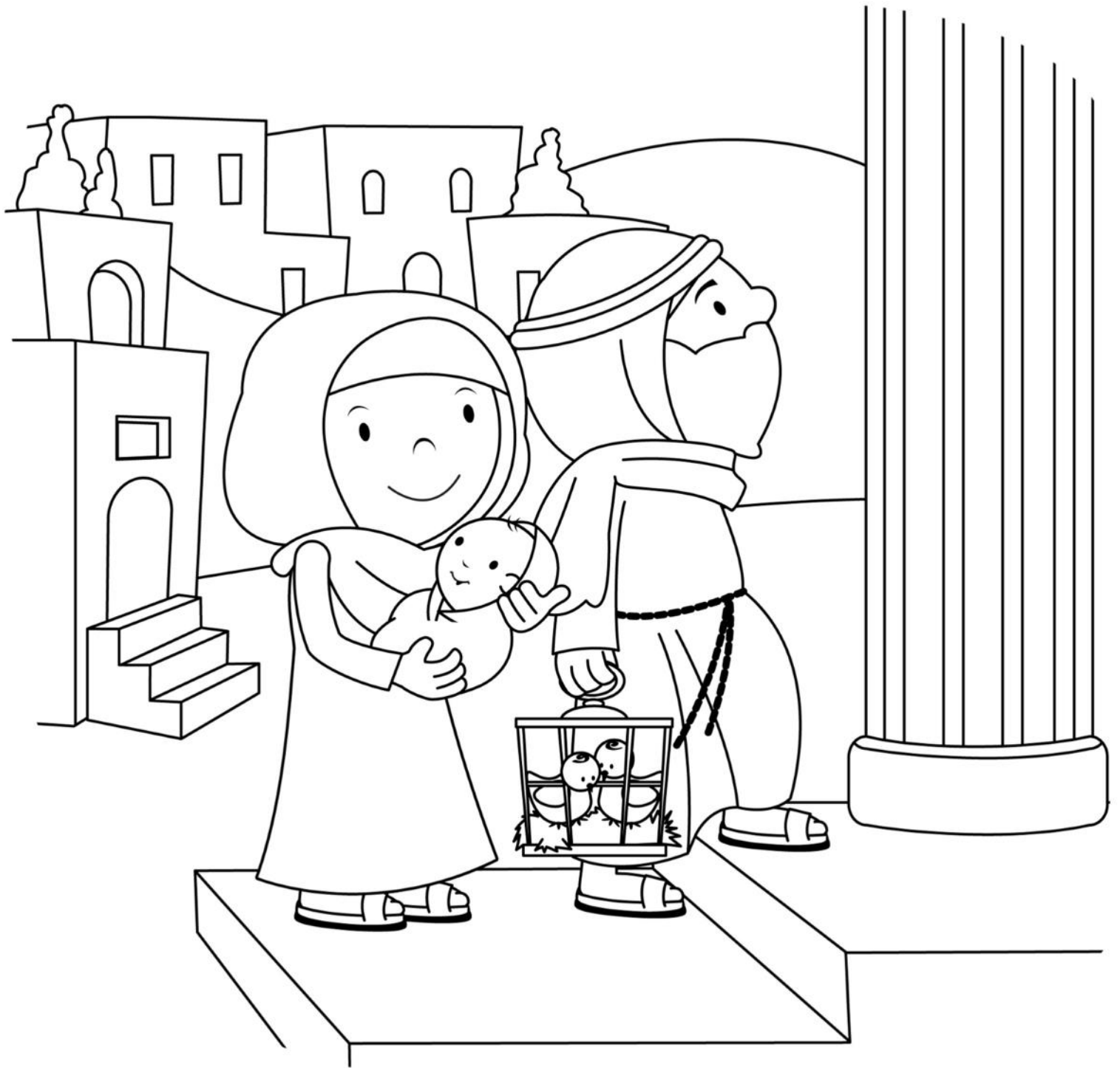
Joseph took Mary as his wife.



When it was almost time for the baby to be born, Joseph and Mary went to Bethlehem to be counted in a census.

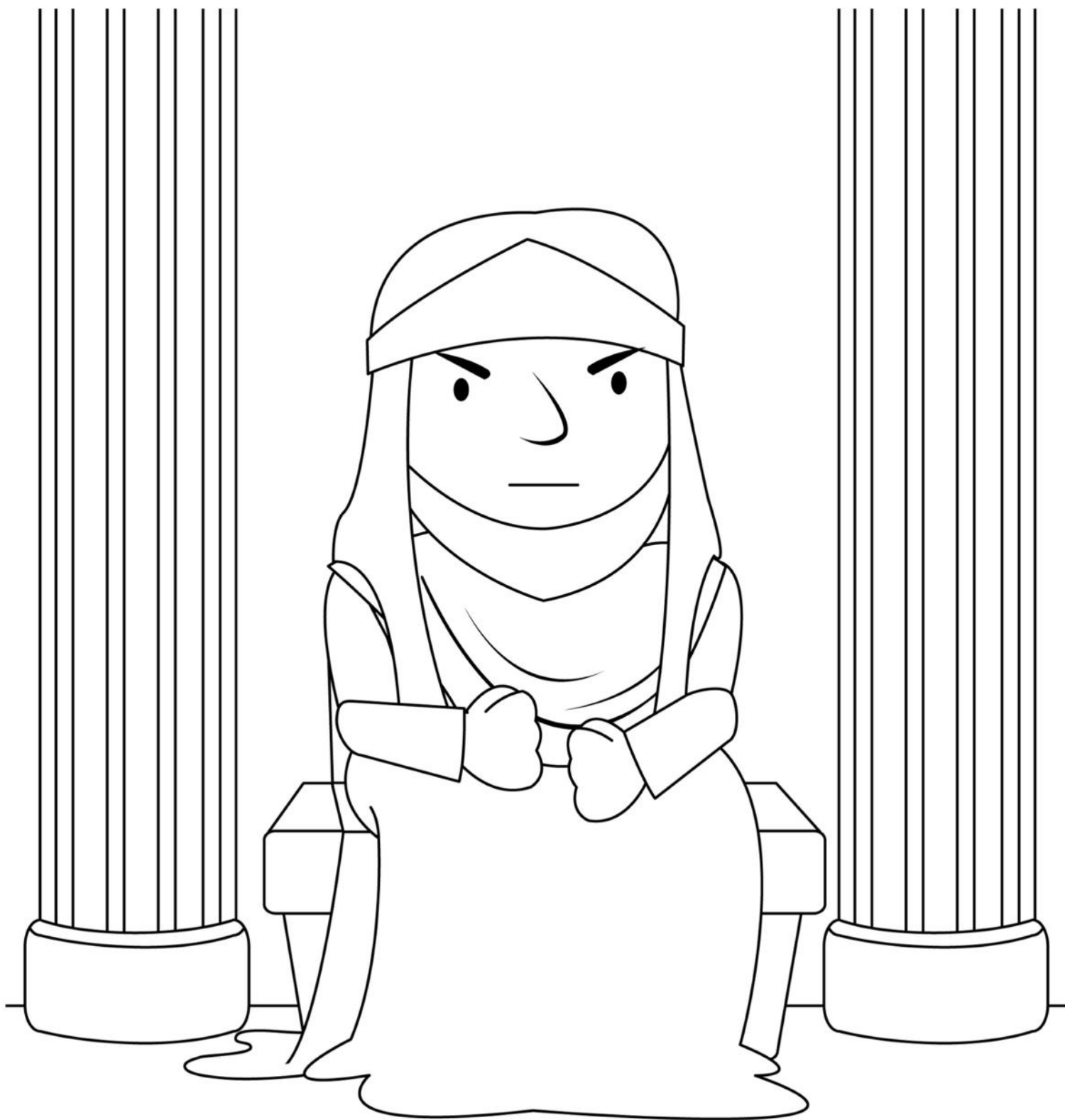


Jesus was born while they were in

Later an angel appeared to Joseph in a dream. The angel said to take Jesus and Mary to Egypt because King Herod wanted to hurt Jesus.

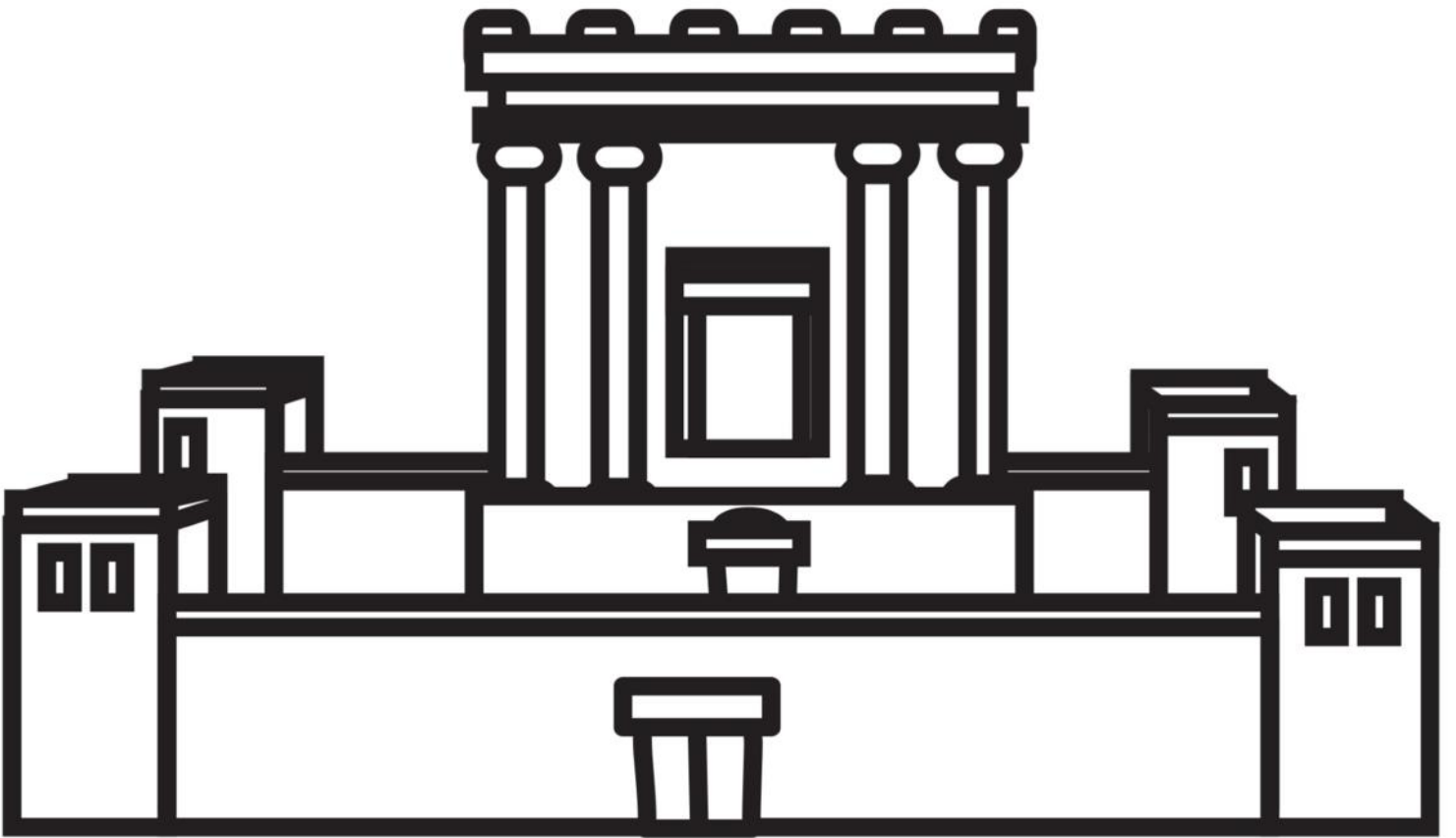


Joseph got up and immediately left for Egypt with Mary and Jesus.



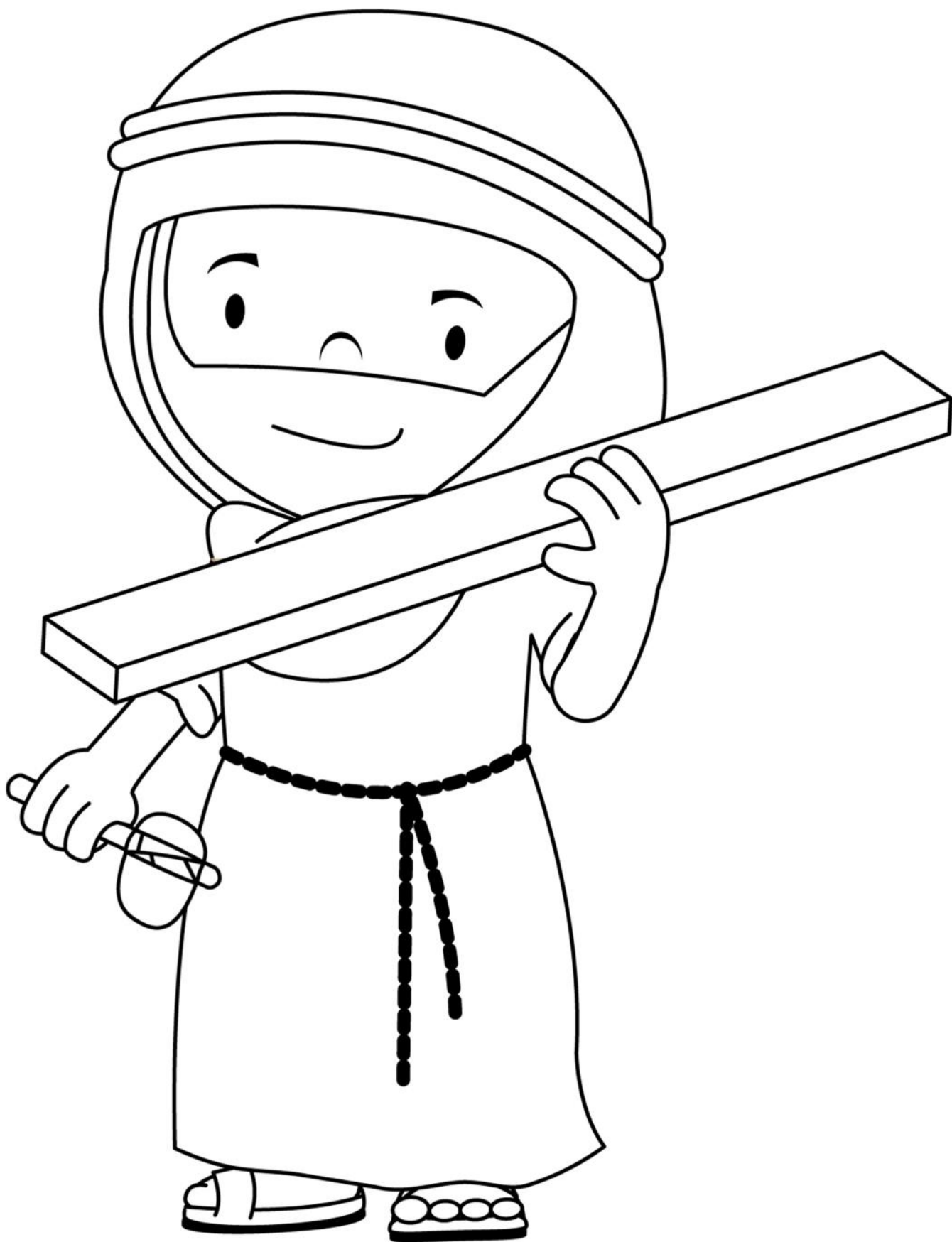
While living in Egypt, an angel appeared again to Joseph in a dream. The angel said it was now safe to leave Egypt with Jesus and Mary.

Jesus was lost! After 3 days of looking for Jesus, Mary and Joseph found him in the temple, listening and asking questions.

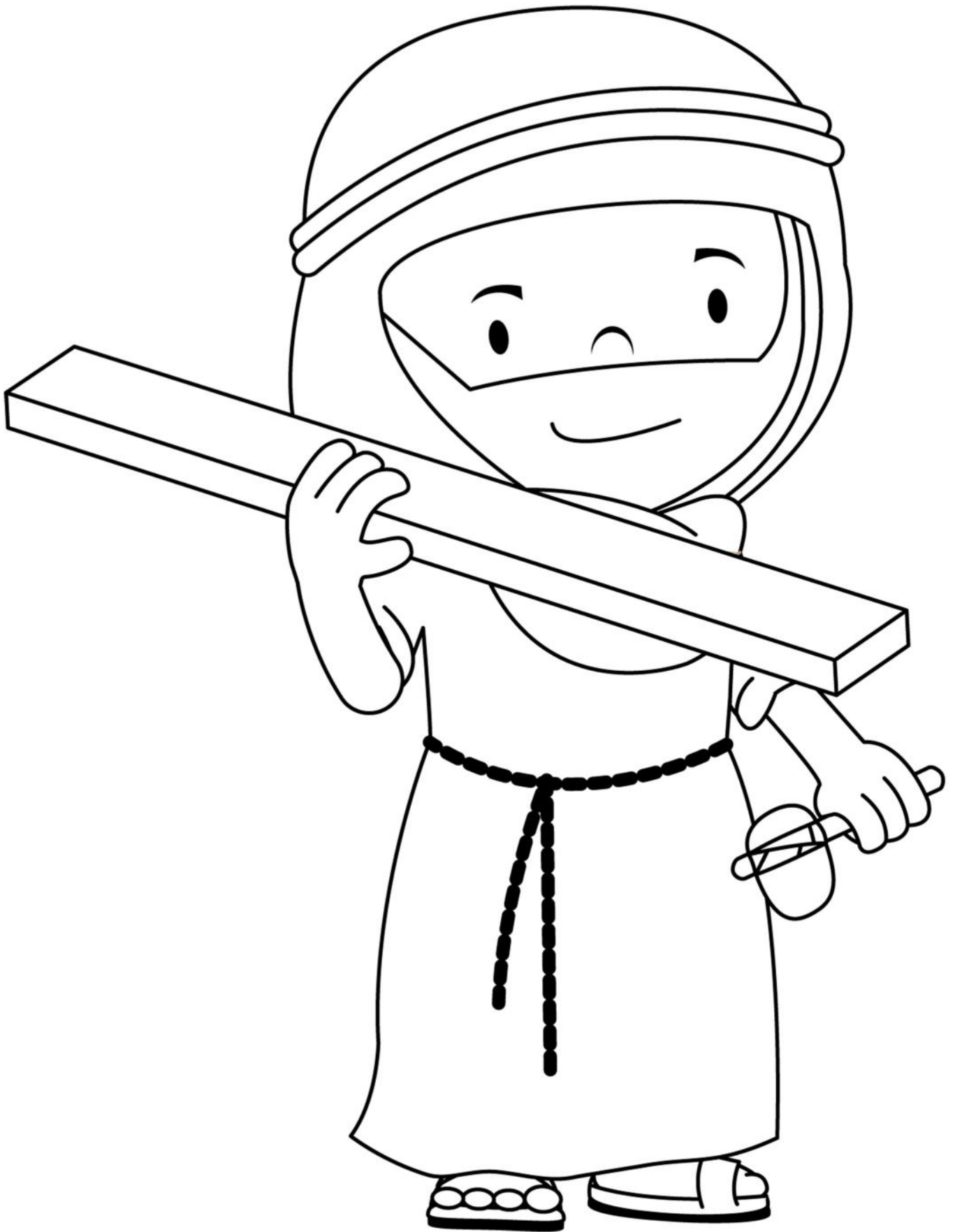


We know that Joseph was a carpenter, someone who built things with wood and stone. As his dad-on-earth, Joseph taught Jesus how to build things, too.
