But Joseph did not know that.




When it came time for God to send us a Savior, the angel Gabriel went to ask Mary if she would be Jesus' mom.

Mary said, "Yes."




The angel told Mary that her cousin, Elizabeth, who was very old, would have a baby! The baby's name would be John.

It was time for Jesus to be born! Jesus was wrapped in cloths, and laid in a manger (a box that animals eat out of).




That night there were shepherds watching their sheep. An angel appeared and told them that Jesus, their Savior, had been born!




Then a choir of angels said, "Glory to God in the highest."
