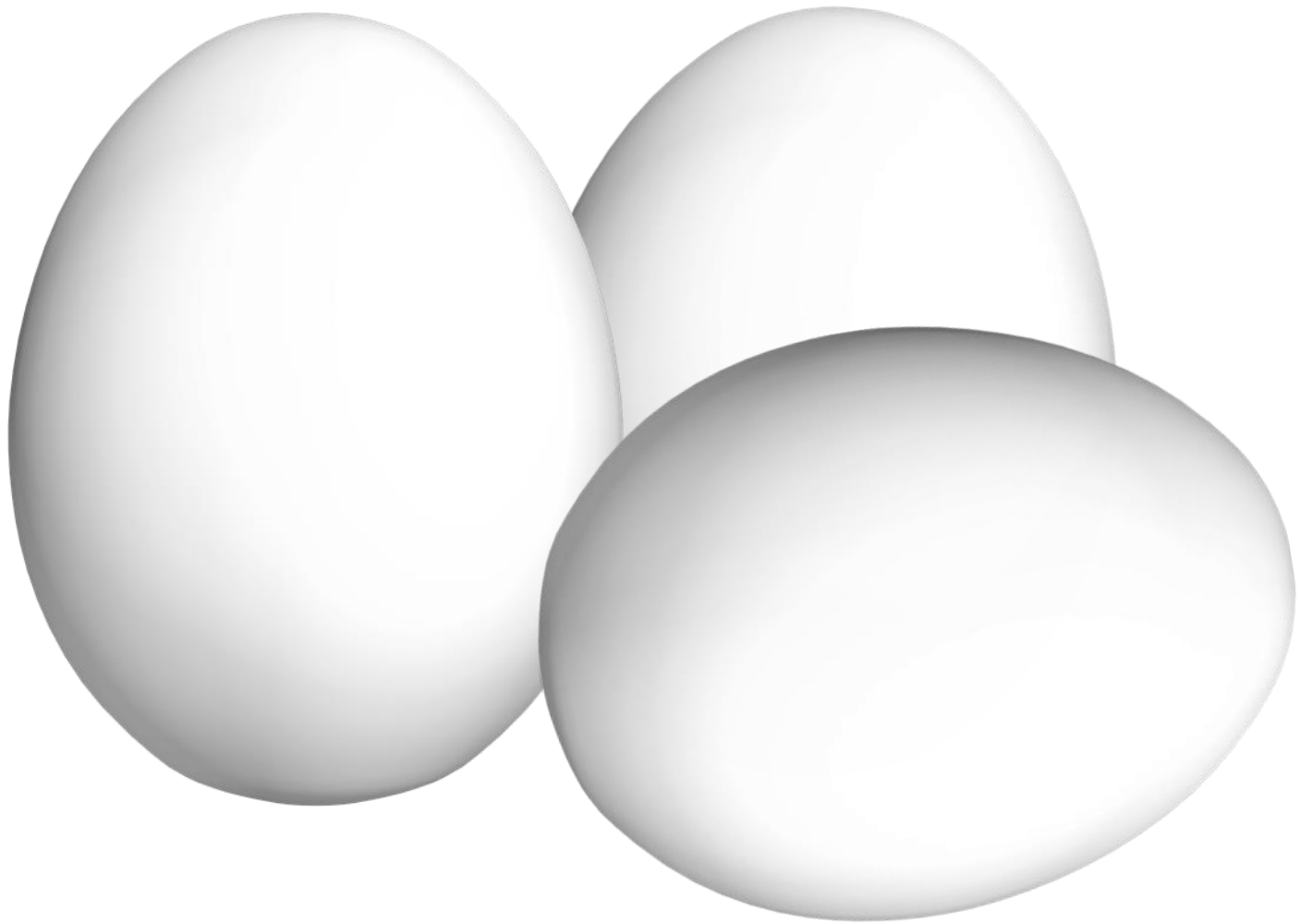

2 — Towel

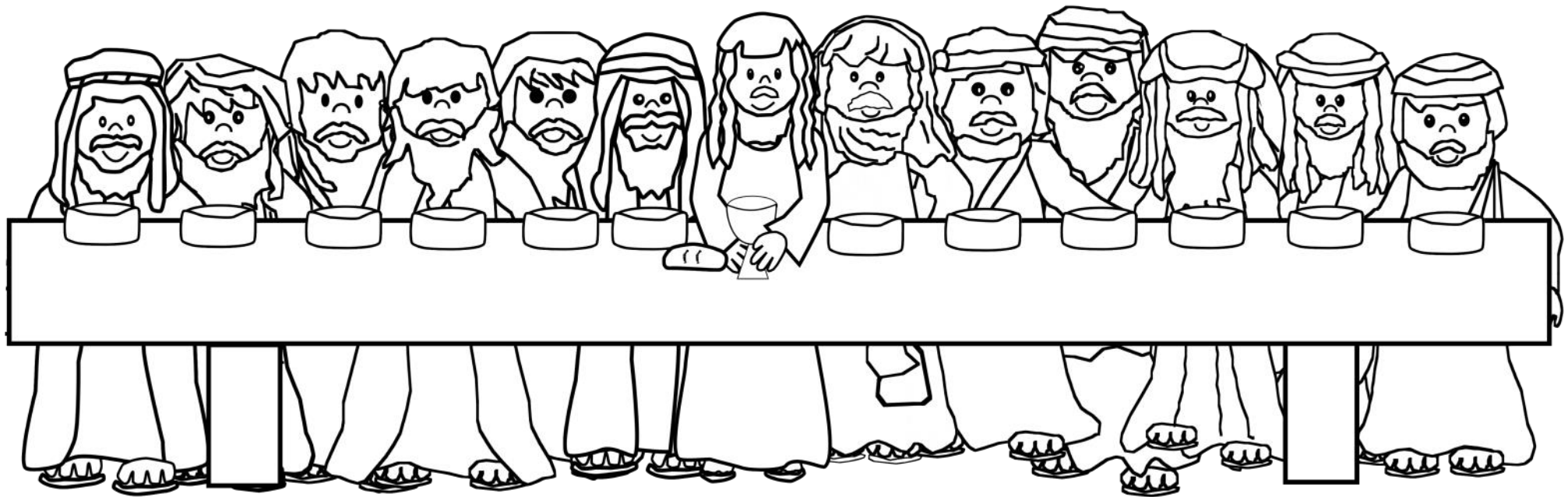
Jesus and his disciples were at supper.

4 — Money

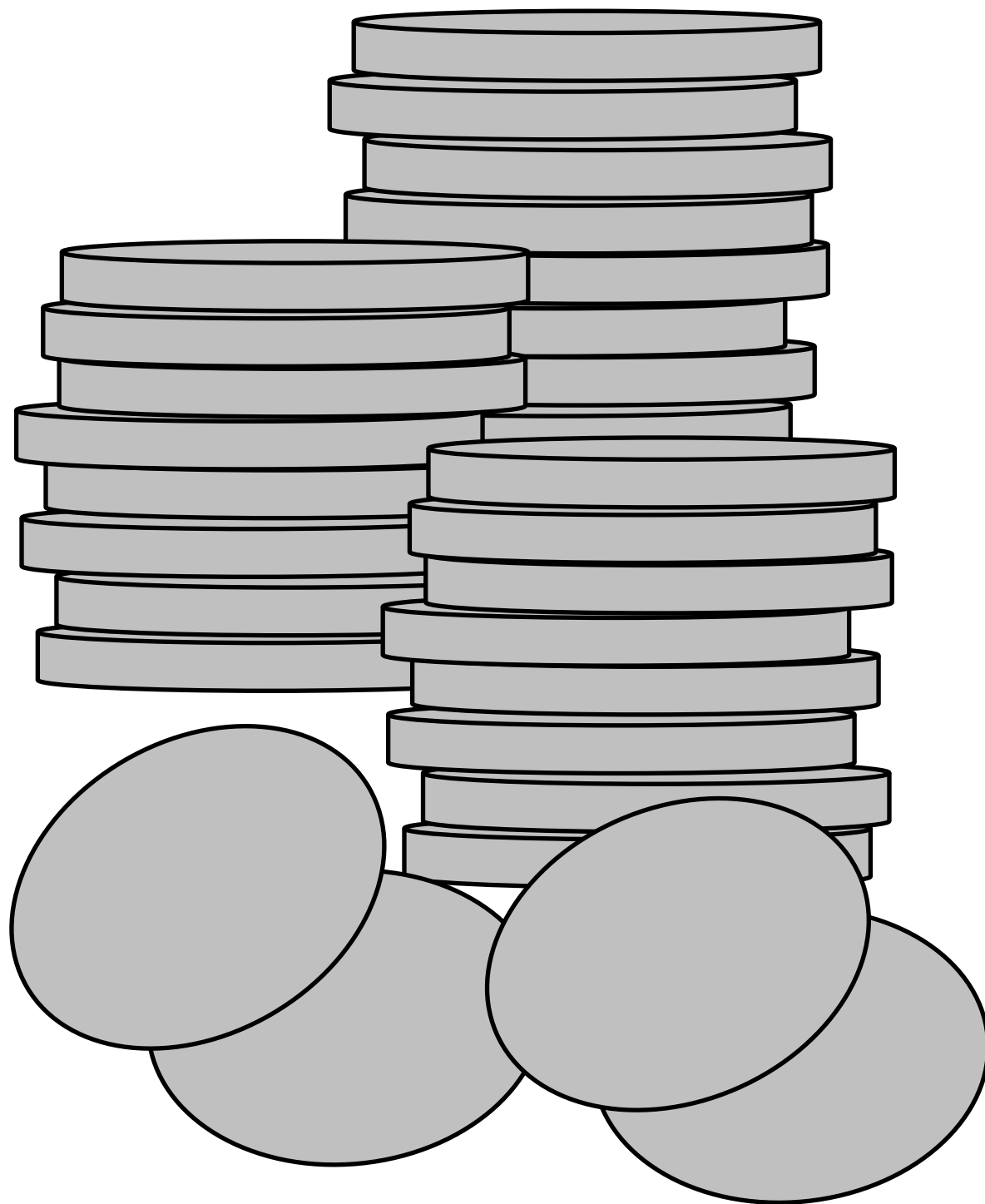

Jesus went to pray at the Mount of Olives.

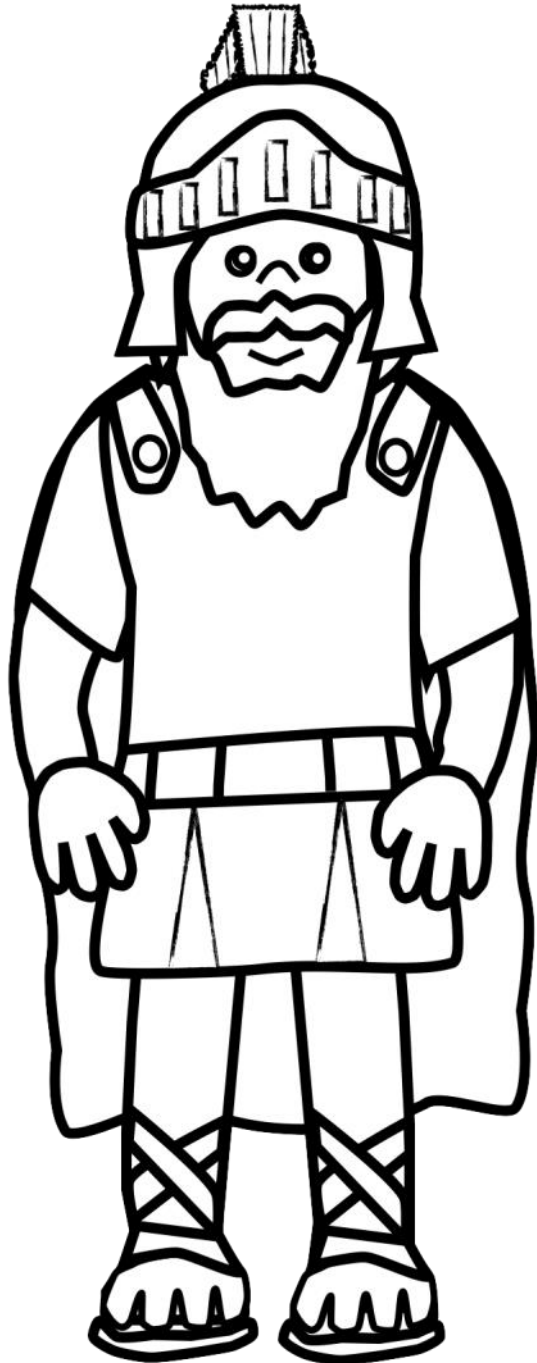
Judas arrived with a large crowd of people.

5 — Rope

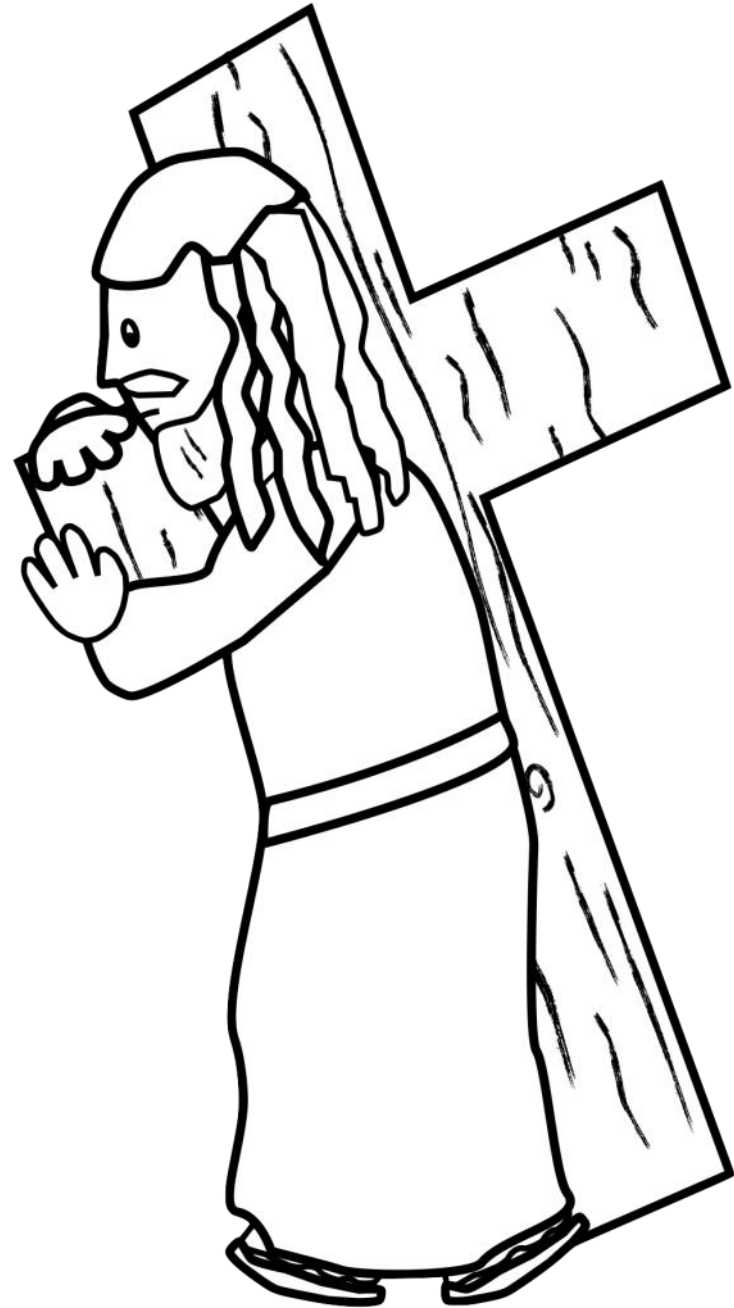


5 — Rope

6 — Cross

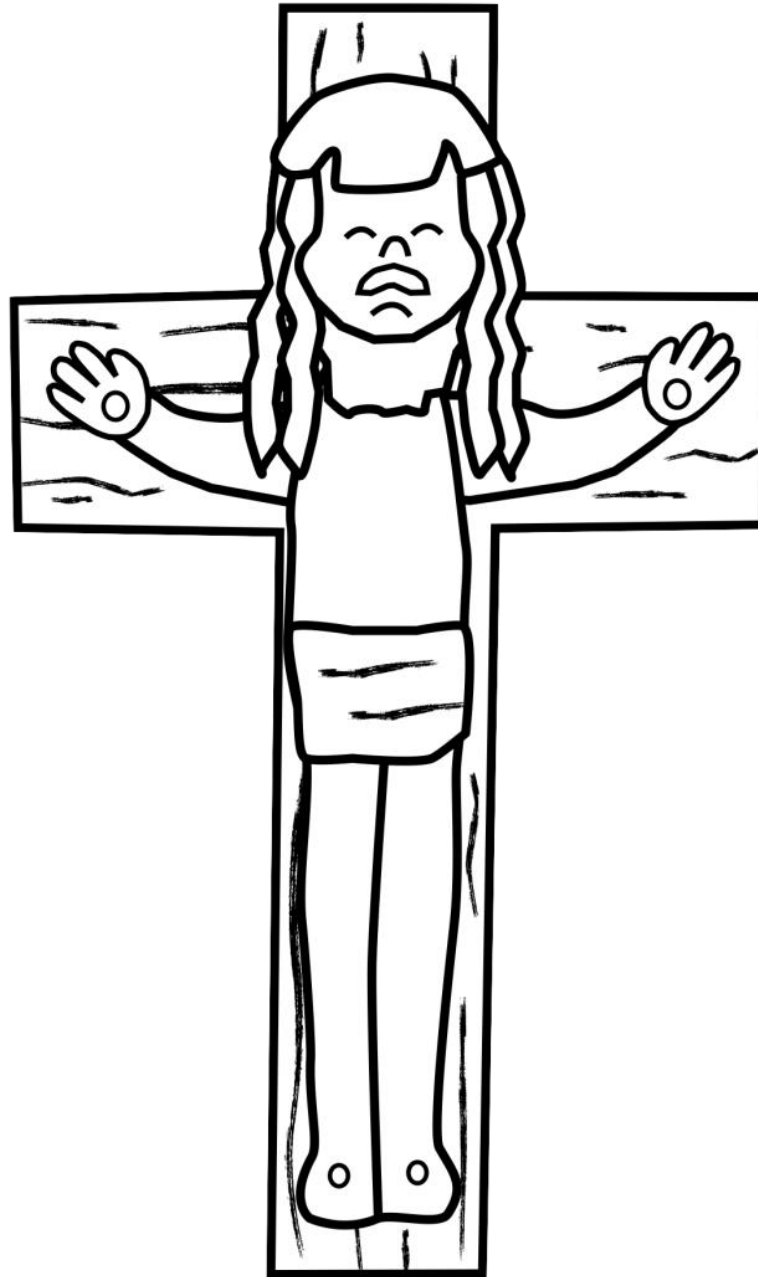
Pontius Pilate handed Jesus over to be crucified.

He fell 3 times.

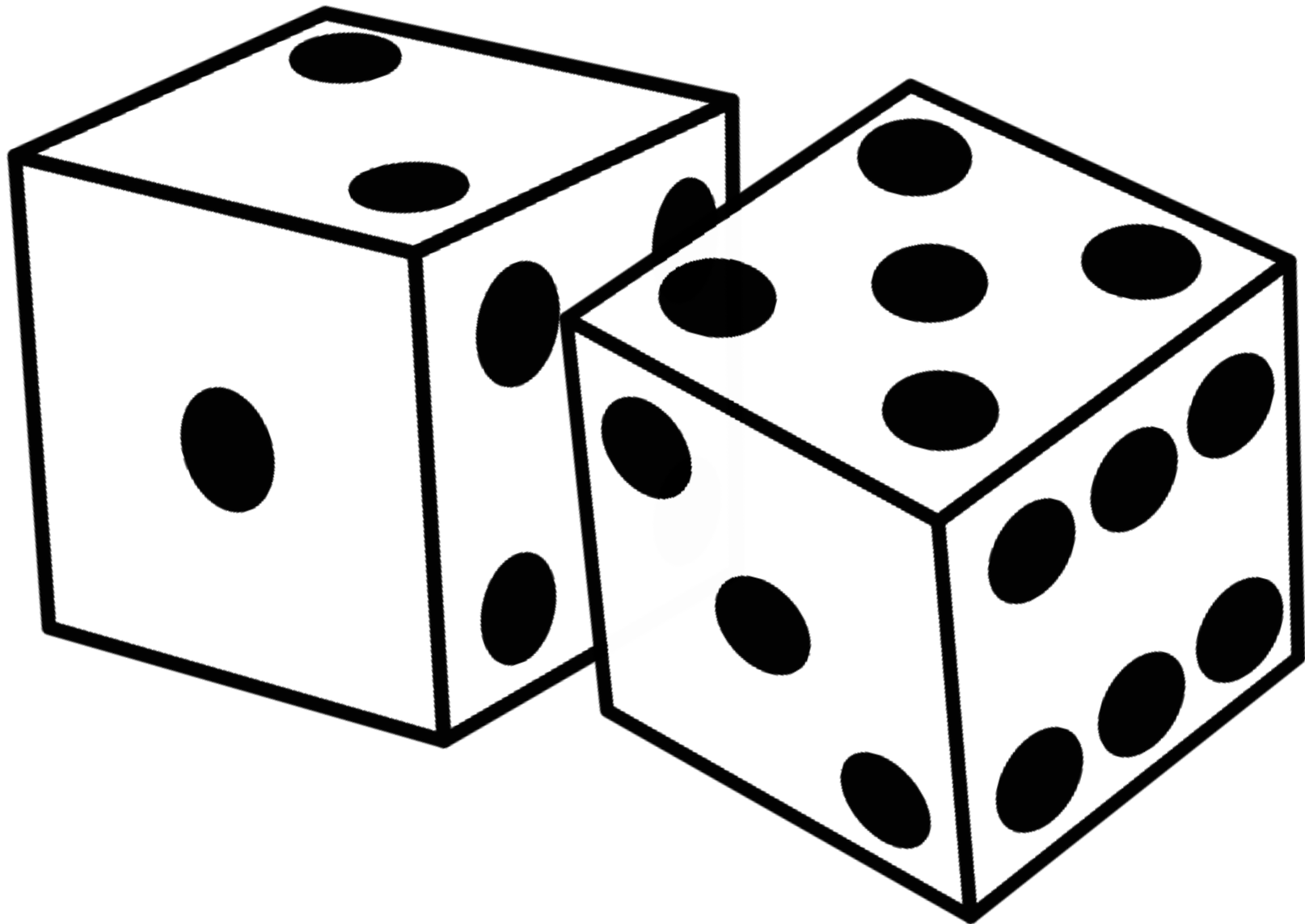
7 — Nail

9 — Sponge

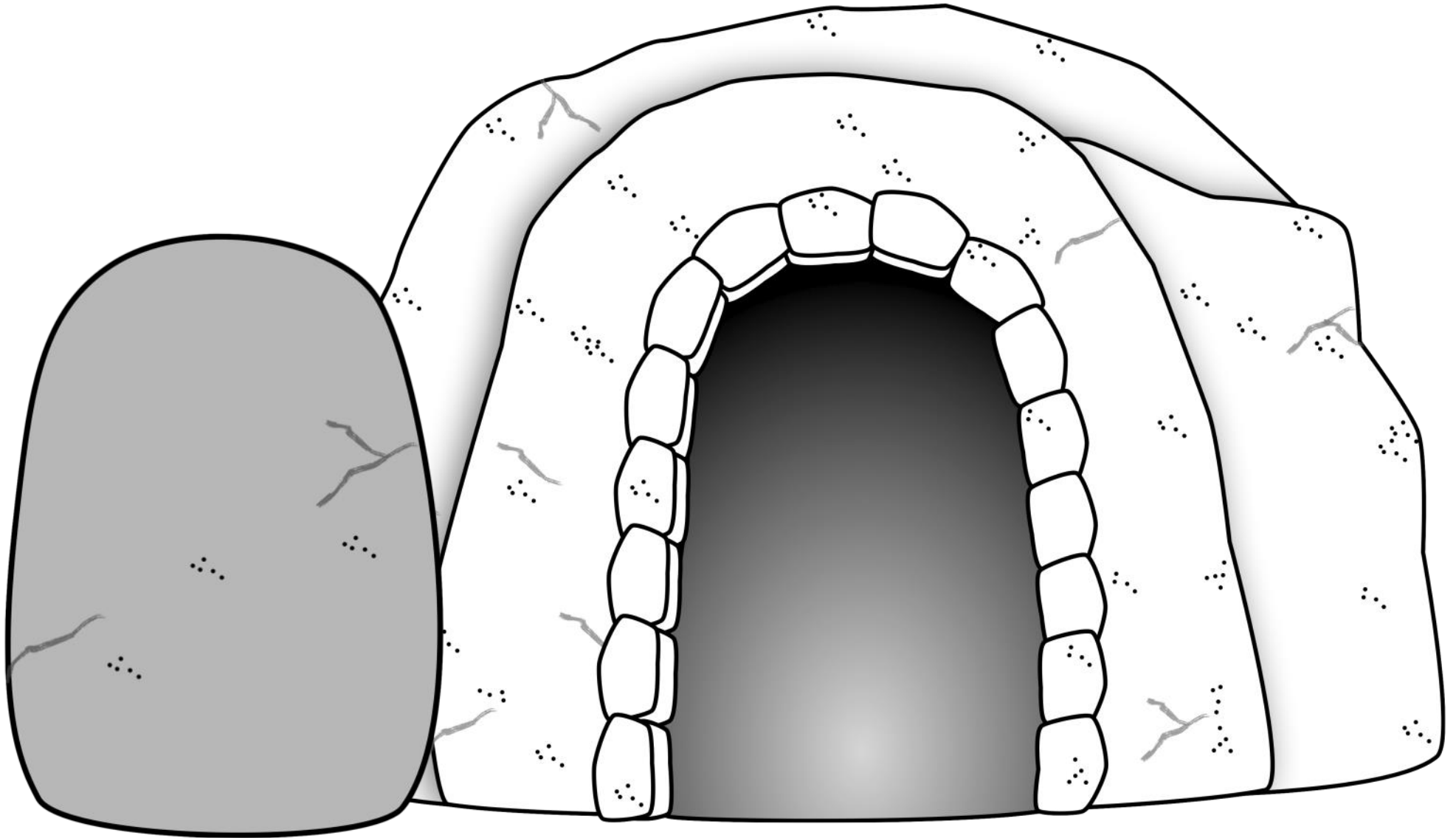
Jesus said, "I am thirsty."

10 — Linen Cloth

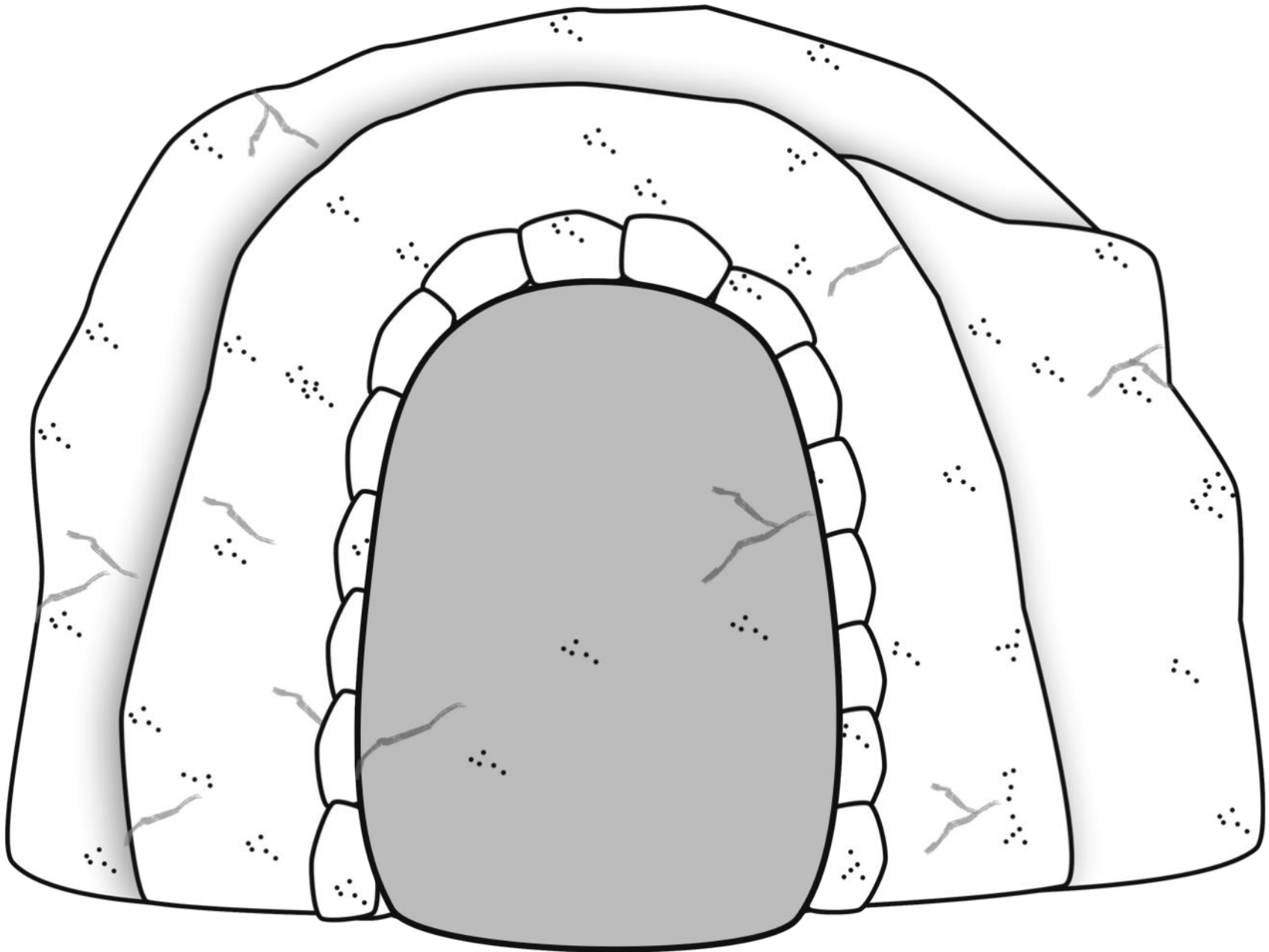


10 — Linen Cloth

He laid Jesus' body in a new tomb.

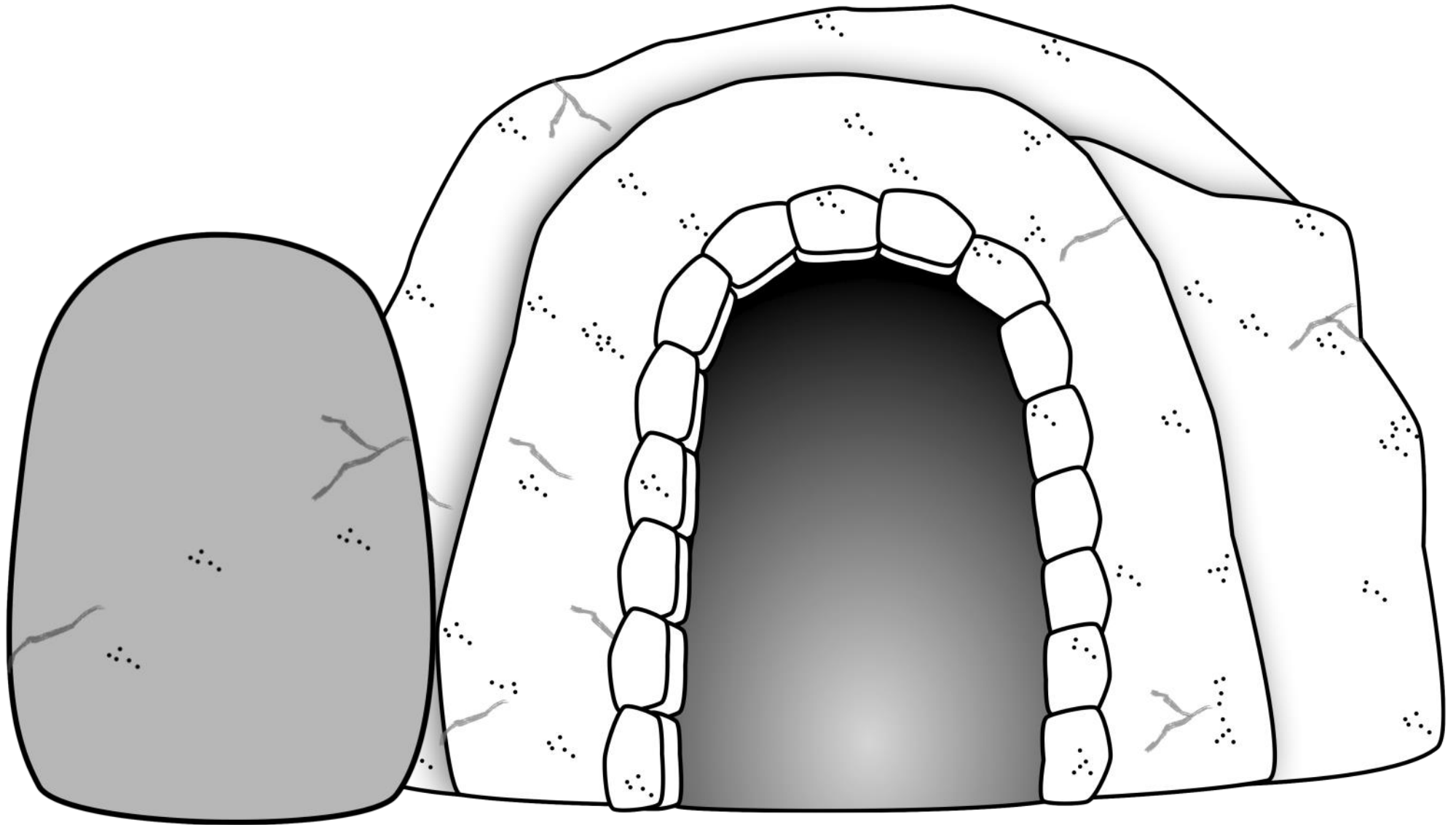
11 — Stone
